\*\*\*\*\*2024 YEAR END AWARDS\*\*\*\*\*

NCRCHA CLUB YEAR END AWARDS WILL BE AS FOLLOWS:

Must be a member in good standing. Show at three of the four shows offered by NCRCHA in 2024 to qualify for any Year-end awards. Year-end awards in all NCRCHA CLUB CLASSES are based on the number of qualified open, youth, or non pro horse and rider combinations. (NRCHA classes do not count towards year end awards.)

Points for awards are as follows – 1 point for winning the class plus one point each of the horses defeated.

No points are awarded if the total score is zero, but the show counts toward meeting requirements to qualify for year-end awards.

In classes with 5 or more qualified exhibitors, CUSTOM AWARDS (examples may include buckles, headstalls, spurs, etc) will be presented to the Champion and Reserve Champions from each of the following NCRCHA CLUB classes: (Qualified exhibitor = member in good standing and show at 3 of the 4 shows during 2024.)

A PLATINUM CERTIFICATE (gift certificate), shall be awarded at the banquet to the one horse, one rider combination with the highest number of points from all classes listed below. Exhibitor must be a member in good standing and show at 3 of the 4 shows.

One PLATINUM CERTIFICATE will be awarded in the OPEN Division to the Horse and Rider combination with the highest number of points accumulated from the following NCRCHA CLUB OPEN classes including but not limited to Open Herd Work, Open Bridle, Open Hackamore, Open Junior Horse, Open Two Rein, Open Reining, Open Working Western Rail, Open Boxing, Open Ranch Trail and Open Ranch Riding.

One PLATINUM CERTIFICATE will be awarded in the NON PRO or YOUTH Division to the Horse and Rider combination (non pro / youth ownership requirements apply) with the highest number of points accumulated from the following NCRCHA CLUB NON PRO or YOUTH classes including but not limited to: Non Pro Herd Work, Non Pro Bridle, Intermediate Non Pro Bridle, Non Pro Hackamore, Non Pro Two Rein, Non Pro Boxing, Limited Non Pro Boxing and Non Pro Box and Drive, Non Pro Reining, Non Pro Working Western Rail, Non Pro Ranch Riding, Non Pro Ranch Trail, Youth Boxing, Youth Cow Horse, Youth Reining 13 & under, Youth Reining 14-18, Youth Working Western Rail 13 & Under, Youth Working Western Rail 14-18, Youth Trail 13 & Under, Youth Ranch Trail 14-18, Youth Ranch Riding 13 & Under, Youth Ranch Riding 14-18.
