NCRCHA MARCH 5-8, 2025

This show will be split into two separate shows. Friday and Saturday will be all the herd work and cow horse classes. Sunday will be all the ranch horse classes. Please use the appropriate entry form for each show and email to the designated show secretary.

REQUIRED HEALTH DOCUMENTS – The California Department of Food and Agriculture requires a health certificate (Certificate of Veterinary Inspection) dated within 30 days and proof of a negative equine infectious anemia test (Coggins or ELISA) dated within 12 months for out of state horses entering California. See the CDFA website for details. Show management does not require health certificates or Coggins for any horses attending the event.

MOVE IN – No earlier than Wednesday March 4, 2026 at 1:00PM

MOVE OUT – No later than Monday March 9, 2026 at 12:00PM




Ranch Reining Pattern #1- Walk / Trot



- ● ● ● Walk
- Trot
- - - - Extended Trot

1. Begin at walk to center of the arena
2. Stop at center of arena
3. Complete 2 spins to the left
4. Complete 2 spins to the right
5. Complete 1 small circle to the right at the trot
6. Complete 1 medium circle to the left at an extended trot
7. Begin a circle to the right but do not close this circle and stop at the center marker
8. Roll back to the left (outside)
9. Trot to continue around the same circle and stop at the end marker
10. Back 10 feet


Walk Trot Ranch Riding



1. Walk
2. Extend the walk
3. Walk to side pass
4. Side Pass to the left
5. Trot
6. Extended Trot
7. Trot
8. Stop
9. Back 10 feet
10. ½ turn to the right
11. Extend trot out of the gate


REINING PATTERN 8



Horses may walk or jog to the center of arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of arena facing the left wall or fence.

1. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate.
2. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
3. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first circle large and fast; the second circle small and slow; the third circle large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
4. Complete three circles to the left: the first circle large and fast; the second circle small and slow; the third circle large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
5. Begin a large circle to the right but do not close this circle. Run straight down the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a left rollback at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence—no hesitation.
6. Continue back around the previous circle but do not close this circle. Run down the left side of the arena past the center marker and do a right rollback at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence—no hesitation.
7. Continue back around the previous circle but do not close this circle. Run down the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence. Back up at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.

2. Extended trot
3. Walk
4. Stop, side pass left over log

8. Collect lope and change leads (simple or flying)
9. Lope left lead
10. Stop and back
11. 1/2 turn right
12. Trot

Note: The drawn description of this pattern is only intended for the general depiction of the pattern. Exhibitors should utilize the arena space to best exhibit their horses.
