This show will be split into two separate shows. Friday and Saturday will be all the herd work and cow horse classes. Sunday will be all the ranch horse classes.

REQUIRED HEALTH DOCUMENTS – The California Department of Food and Agriculture requires a health certificate (Certificate of Veterinary Inspection) dated within 30 days and proof of a negative equine infectious anemia test (Coggins or ELISA) dated within 12 months for out of state horses entering California. See the CDFA website for details. Show management does not require health certificates or Coggins for any horses attending the event.

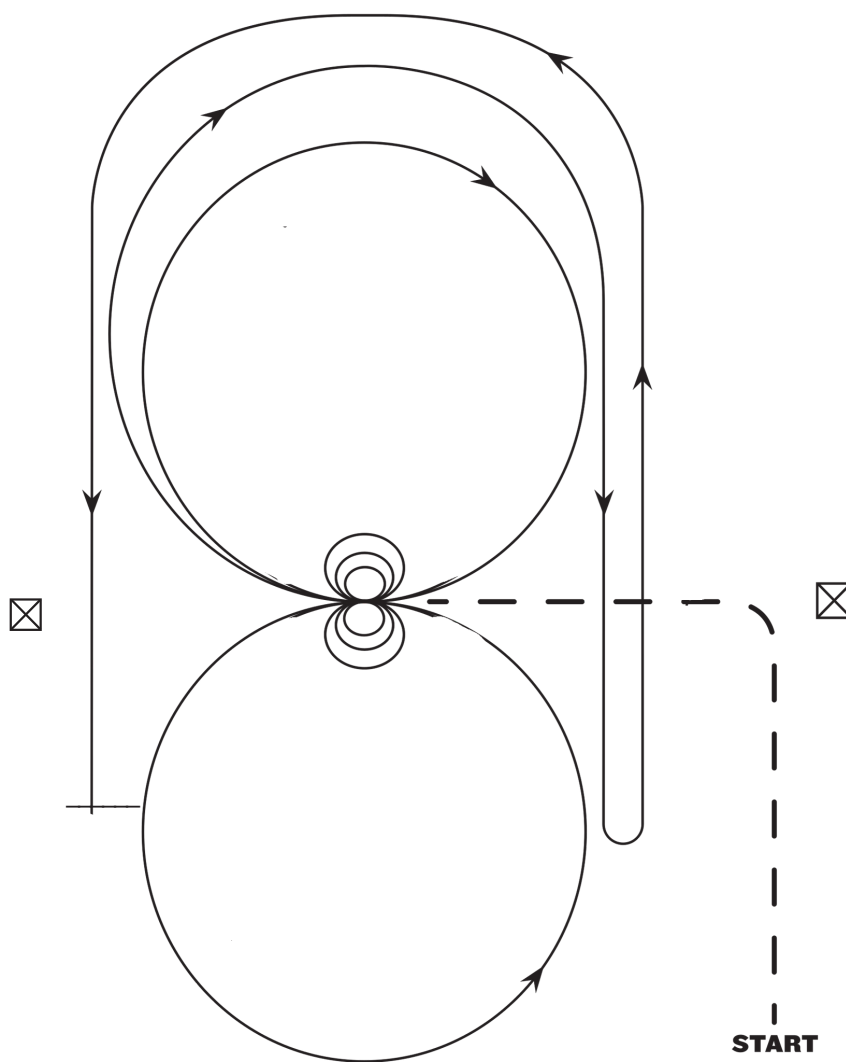

WALK-TROT REINING

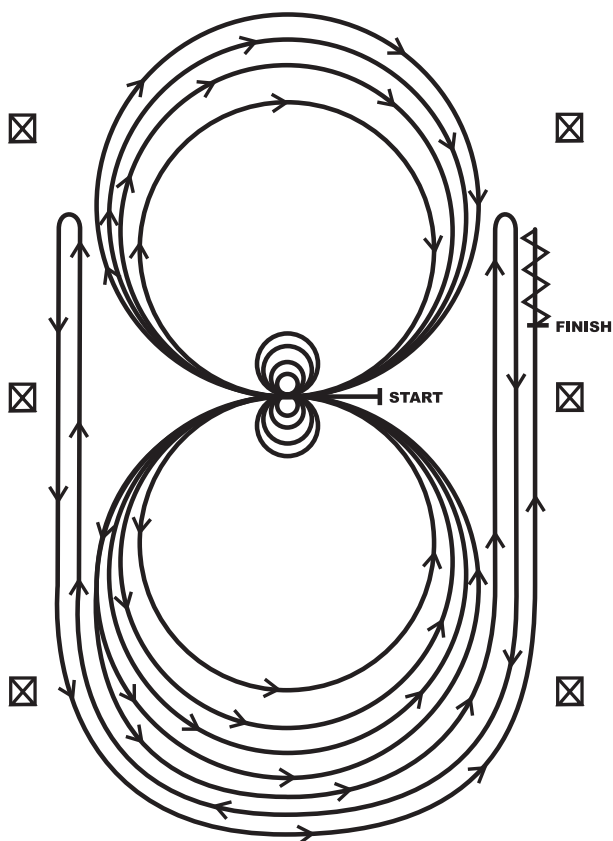
All Divisions



Ride pattern as follows:

1. Trot to center of arena and stop.
2. Complete 2 spins or walk 2 small circles in one direction. Hesitate.
3. Complete 2 spins or walk 2 small circles in the opposite direction. Hesitate.
4. Begin to the right at the trot, complete one circle. Change direction at the center of arena.
5. Complete one circle to the left at the trot. Change direction at the center of arena.
6. Begin a circle to the right at the extended trot, but do not close this circle. Extend the trot down the side of the arena past the center marker, complete a stop, and do a left roll back at least 20 feet from the wall or fence, no hesitation.
7. Continue back around the previous circle extending the trot, but do not close this circle. Extend the trot down the side of the arena past the center marker, and make a complete stop at least 20 feet from the wall or fence. Back up at least 10 feet. Hesitate to show completion of the pattern.

REINING PATTERN 5 All Lope Divisions

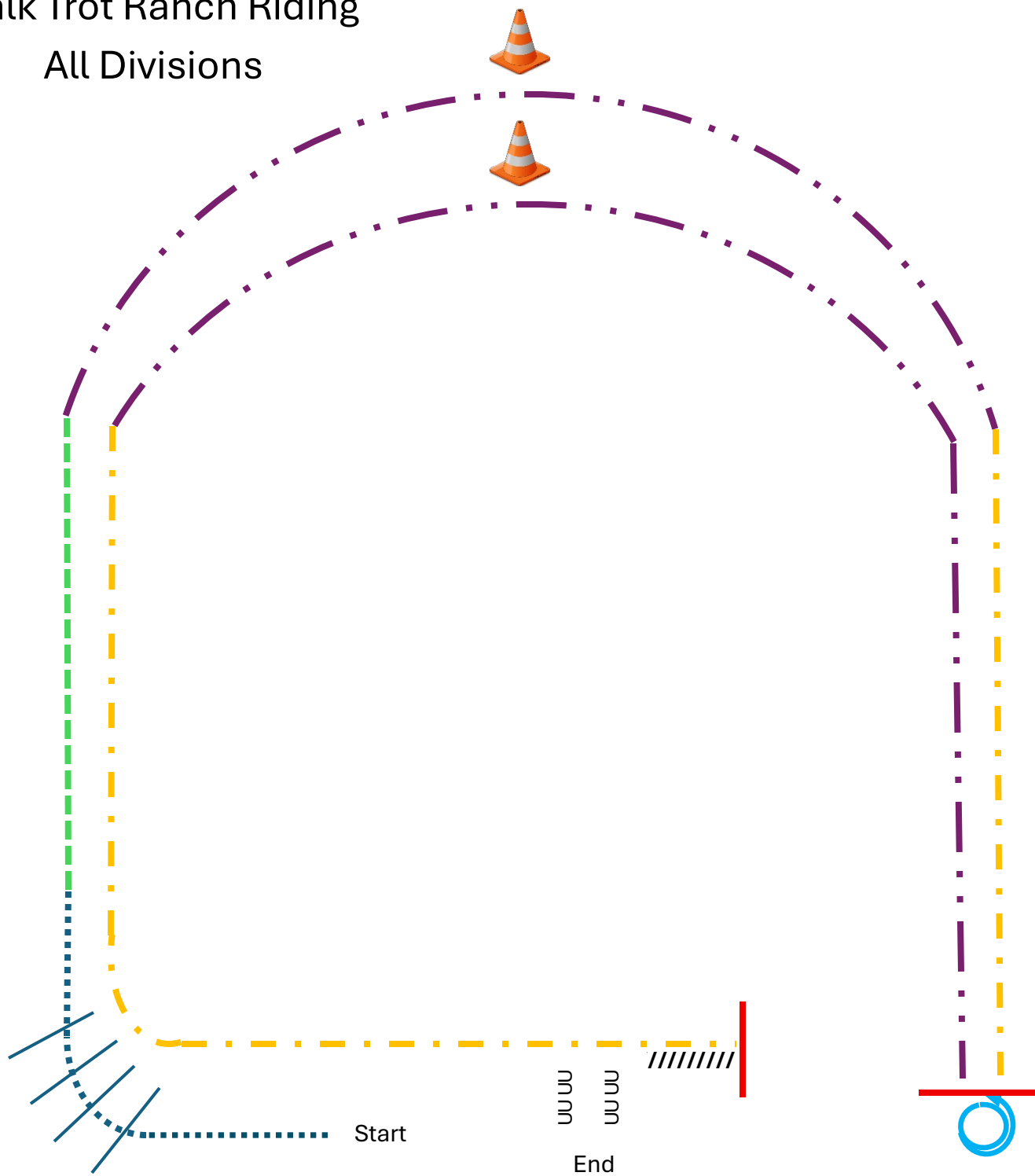


Horses may walk or jog to the center of arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

1. Beginning on the left lead, complete three circles to the left: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena. Hesitate.
2. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate.
3. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena. Hesitate.
4. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
5. Beginning on the left lead, run a large fast circle to the left, change leads at the center of the arena, run a large fast circle to the right, and change leads at the center of the arena. (Figure 8)
6. Continue around previous circle to the left but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a right rollback at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence—no hesitation.
7. Continue around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the left side of the arena past the center marker and do a left rollback at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence—no hesitation.
8. Continue back around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence. Back up at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.

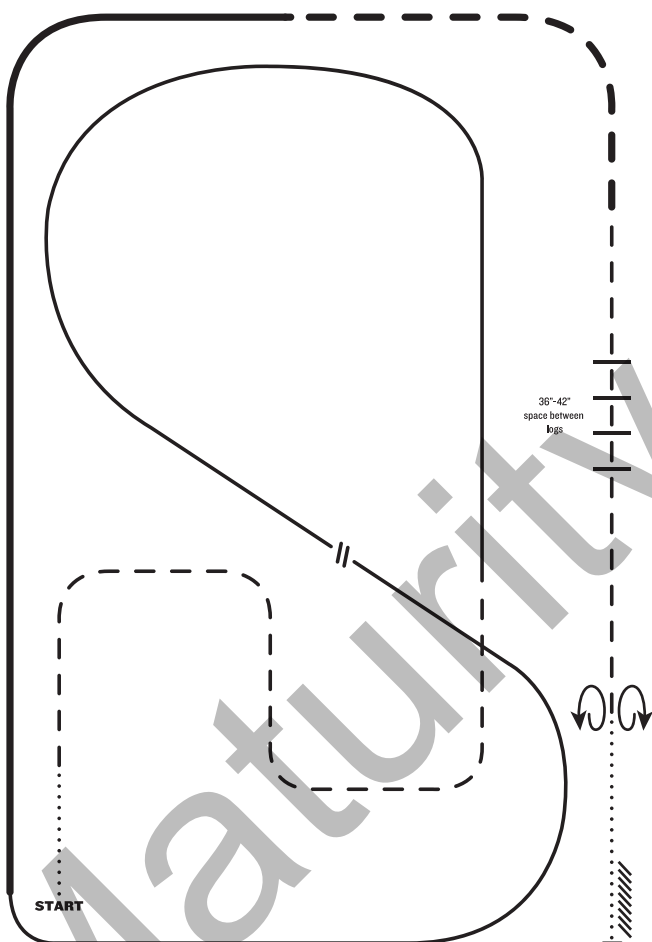
Walk Trot Ranch Riding

1. Walk to and over poles
2. Extend walk to corner
3. Extended trot between cones
4. Trot
5. Stop
6. 1 ½ turns to the left
7. Extended trot inside of cone
8. Trot
9. Stop
10. Back
11. Side pass

RANCH RIDING - PATTERN 3 - MATURITY

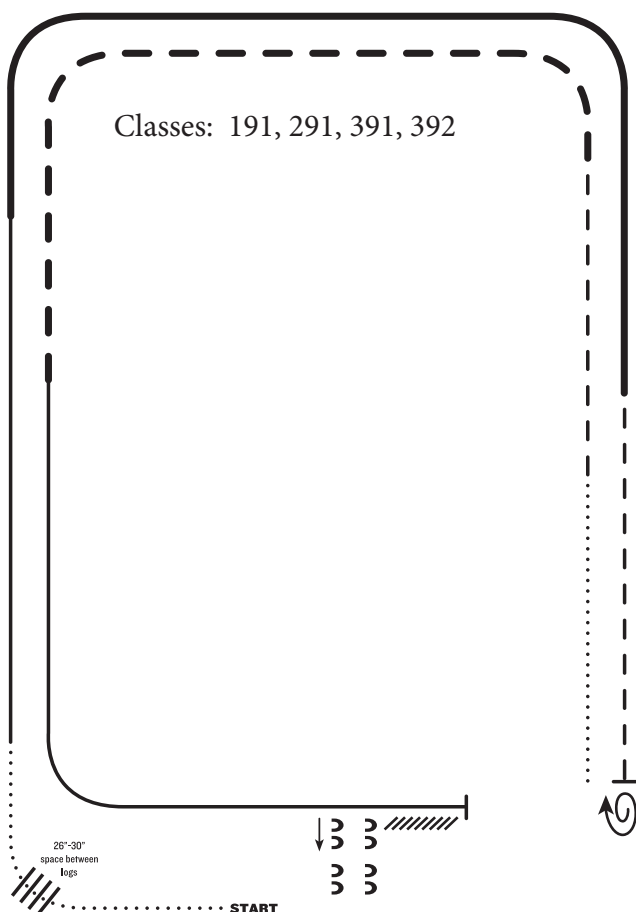

1. Walk
2. Trot serpentine
3. Lope left lead around the end of the arena and then diagonally across the arena
4. Change leads (simple or flying)
5. Lope right lead around end of the arena
6. Extend lope on the straight away and around corner to the center of the arena
7. Extend trot around corner of the arena
8. Collect to a trot
9. Trot over logs
10. Stop, 360° turn each direction (either direction 1st) (L-R or R-L)
11. Walk, stop and back
